Mormoreto is Castello di Nipozzano's most prestigious wine, produced from the vineyard of the same name, planted 150 years ago.

- Since its first vintage in 1983, Mormoreto is produced only in the most favorable vintages.
- The wine represents a careful assemblage of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petite Verdot.
- The Mormoreto vineyard lies at elevations of 300 and 400 meters.
- 150 years of experience in the cultivation of the grapes provide insights into the precise spot best suited to each variety.
- 28 days of maceration followed by 24 months of ageing in French oak barriques allows elegant, intriguingly spicy and long-lived flavors to develop.

TASTING PROFILE Complex blueberry and blackberry flavors, great structure, and a long finish with notes of spice, leather and tobacco.

FOOD PAIRING Roast beef, all grilled meats, hearty stews and aged cheeses.
