Tenuta di Castiglioni is the iconic wine of the oldest Tuscan estate owned by the Frescobaldi family.

- Tenuta di Castiglioni is rich, elegant and clearly made in a modern style, but it holds fast to the qualities of its local terroir.
- IGT Toscana: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Sangiovese.
- Severe fruit selection at harvest and hand harvesting ensures the selection of only healthy bunches and the gentler handling of the grapes.
- Stainless steel fermentation at controlled temperatures.
- 12 days of maceration followed by 12 months in new French oak barriques.

TASTING PROFILE Full body, intense aromatics, bright fruit. Vibrant, with notes of currants, blackberry and flowers. Polished sweet tannins and a lingering finish.

FOOD PAIRING Wood-fire pizza, grilled polenta, braised beef, mushroom risotto, and sharp cheeses.
