“Saturated, deep ruby-red. Flamboyant aromas of plum, strawberry, leather and dried flowers, with a pronounced roasted oak component. Then rich and chewy yet somehow suave in the mouth, with dark fruit flavors complicated by game, underbrush and minerals. Impressively dense, fat, large-scaled barbera with a mellow, very long finish featuring lush, silky tannins and considerable sweetness. **Hardly your typical barbera, and that's not meant as a complaint!** This is a joint project involving Coppo, Chiarlo, Vietti, Prunotto, Braida and Berta.”

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
