2000: *89* *“Cherry, kirsch and licorice flavors are bright in this vivid red. Firm tannins are well-integrated, the structure balanced and accessible.”*

2001: *88* *“This red is silky and polished for Priorat, with high-toned berry and cherry flavors framed by sweet vanilla. It shows some intensity, but remains easy to like.”*

2002: *89* *“Fresh blueberry aromas and flavors give this red an immediate appeal, deepened by sweet vanilla accents. The wine is focused and fresh, gentle yet lively, and brings you back for another sip.”*

2003: *93* *“This plush red delivers ripe, fresh flavors in a velvety texture, with well-integrated tannins and just enough acidity to keep it lively. Modern in style, with blueberry, toast, vanilla and mineral flavors.”*

2003: *90* *“Aromatic nose combines dark berries, spices, violet and licorice. Dense, lush...seamless, deep wine that finishes with lush, building tannins and lingering sweetness.”*

This estate-bottled 2000 exhibits...a sweet nose of blackberries, strawberries, and cherries intermixed with this region's tell-tale notes of minerals and crushed stones. Medium to full-bodied, with moderate tannin...elegant, well-delineated personality.”*
