



2007 MEDUSA OLD VINE ZINFANDEL  
PIG PEN VINEYARD, DEAVER RANCH,  
AMADOR COUNTY

Gentle rolling slopes and vibrant red soil accentuate Pig Pen vineyard's unique rich berry character. The site was planted in 1978 and named for the fencing that surrounds the vineyard, protecting the luscious berries from wild boar. A pre-fermentation cold soak captured the bright fruit expression in the wine, which possesses a spicy bouquet with undertones of black cherry and deep tannins.
