Grape variety: Nebbiolo

Subarea: Albesani

Vineyard: Santo Stefano (Village of Neive)

Exposure: Southwest

Soil: clay-calcareous

Age of vines: 20-30 years

Vineyard density: 4,000 vines per hectare

Harvest date: 28 September 2009

Fermentation and maceration: about 15 days in stainless steel vats

Refinement: 18 months in French oak barrels (Allier) + 2 months in bottle

Bottling: July 2011

Bottles produced: 7,253 bottles 0.75 lt.

Alcohol: 14.50% vol.

Total acidity: 5.35 g/L

pH: 3.54

Total extract: 26 g/L

Sensory analysis:

Red garnet color. The bouquet presents red fruit and spice notes. On the palate, it is full, complex, structured.

Optimal period for consumption: 2012-2022
