



BODEGAS LEDA

Bodegas Leda produces great multiterroir wines from the variety of grape Tempranillo obtained from very old vines. These unique terroirs are from the Duero Valley and specially chosen one by one in order to give life to this project. It has a production limited to 80,000 bottles. Leda wines are expressive and harmonic, wines with roots, which reflect the richness and strength heterogeneity of their origin.

Garcia family, co-owner with Casa Masaveu Wineries & Vineyards of Leda Winery, is responsible for the winemaking process and Eduardo Garcia, the son of the prestigious winemaker Mariano Garcia, is the Technical Director of the winery.

Vintage: 2007.

Origin: Castilla y León (Duero Valley)- Spain.

Type of wine: multiterroir (wine assembly of several plots).

Variety: 100% Tempranillo.

Comments: it is made from selected vineyards of the Tempranillo variety of very low yield bottled after spending 13 months in oak barrels (90% French and 10% American).

Tasting note:

In nose is suggestive and perfumed and offers a rich aromatic palette: red candied fruit, liquorice, roasted...

Fresh, succulent and very balanced in the mouth, with polished tannins that invite drink. It is a gourmet version, modern and accessible.
