Porrera VI DE VILA

Following in the tradition of the Vins du Village in Burgundy, France, the new *Vins de Vila* of Priorat allow the name of the village to be used when naming a wine, as long as 100% of the grapes in the wine were grown within the boundaries of that municipality. Celler Vall Llach created their Porrera Vi de Vila to be a wine of the highest quality and a homage to the people of the village - a village that has embraced the winery and now defines its spirit.

What makes the village of Porrera unique?

Year of foundation: 1204

Number of inhabitants: 485

Number of Porrera grape growers who lie within the DOQ Priorat: 91

Land under vine: Of the 2,800ha within the Porrera municipality, 386 are planted with vines (13.8%).

Rock & soil composition: Silty & granitized slate, with only a very small top layer of actual soil, typically 5 to 20 cm thick.

Climate: Sitting at 19.3 km from the Mediterranean Sea, Porrera's weather is significantly influenced by it, experiencing more humidity and typically more rain (avg. 550mm annually) than other regions of Priorat.

Altitude: The village lies at 316m above sea level and its vineyards are planted between 200 and 600m.



Introducing Porrera Vi de Vila de Vall Llach...

A tribute to a village, its townspeople and its indigenous old-vines, the Porrera Vi de Vila is a blend of 70% old-vine Cariñena & 30% old-vine Garnacha. Black currant, balsamic, fresh almond and forest herb aromas lead to fleshy, tasty and expressive flavors with silky tannins and an interminable finish.

The 100% estate-owned fruit for Porrera Vi de Vila is sourced from 4 vineyards:
