80% Sangiovese, 15% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

9 months in barriques and tonneaux followed by another 3 to 6 months of bottle aging.

A linear version, with cherry, raspberry, graphite, and underbrush flavors framed by toasty oak. Firms up on the finish. Drink now through 2022. - - Bruce Sanderson
