TASTING NOTES

Intense ruby red color. Complex nose with fruity aromas of red fruits, plums, balsamic hints and vanilla scents. The entry is firm but elegant, with sweet tannins and balanced acidity. The finish is long with excellent persistence. It is the "grand vin" of Brolio.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Sangiovese 90%, Cabernet Sauvignon 5%, Petit Verdot 5%

AGING

18 months in tonneaus (30% new).

Wine Spirits 91 POINTS

This is a blend of sangiovese, with five percent each cabernet sauvignon and petit verdot, selected from the best parcels of this estate's 560 acres. The wine's ripe flavors of dark cherry and plum reflect the warmth of the 2015 vintage, its fruit tones enriched by subtle spice and loamy earth tones.
