TASTING NOTES

Intense ruby red color. Complex nose with fruity aromas of red fruits, plums, balsamic hints and vanilla scents. The entry is firm but elegant, with sweet tannins and balanced acidity. The finish is long with excellent persistence. It is the "grand vin" of Brolio.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Sangiovese 90%, Cabernet Sauvignon 5%, Petit Verdot 5%

AGING

18 months in tonneaus (30% new).

Wine Spectator 93 POINTS

Sweet, ripe cherry and raspberry flavors define this Chianti Classico from start to finish, augmented by almond, iron and tar accents, with a hefty dose of grainy tannins. All the elements come together on the juicy aftertaste. Best from 2021 through 2036. — *BS*
