THE WINERY

Since its founding in the early 1990s by celebrated singer Lluís Llach and notary Enric Costa, Celler Vall Llach has committed itself to rigorous quality standards. Located in the tiny mountain town of Porrera in the D.O.Q. Priorat, the winery is now headed by Enric's son Albert as winemaker, general manager and co-owner.

The magnificent century-old estate vineyards boast 60- to 90-year-old Cariñena and Garnache vines as well as newer plantings of Garnache, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah that add complexity to Vall Llach's range of widely acclaimed wines. Priorat's notoriously stingy llicorella (fractured black slate) hillsides produce extremely low yields of intensely flavored grapes.

THE WINE

In the rocky hills about 2 hours south of Barcelona and only 12 miles inland from the Mediterranean Sea, lies the ancient village of Porrera in the D.O.Q. Priorat. A tribute to the village, its townspeople and its indigenous varietals, Celler Vall Llach created their Porrera Vi de Vila to be a wine of the highest quality and a homage to the people of Porrera.

AGING

Aged in new 300L French oak barrels for 14 months, racked once and bottled in May of 2018.

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
