HARVEST METHOD	Hand-Harvested
VINIFICATION	Destemmed, lightly crushed. Pump-overs and delestage 3 times a day. Max. Temp. 30° C. Extended maceration 30 days.
ANALYTICS	ALCOHOL 14.5% ACIDITY 5.88 g/L
OAK AGING	14 months in 100% new French oak barrels (light toast)
TASTING NOTES	Wafting aromas of red currants, black cherries and mildly smoky and sweet vanilla oak. Layers of currant fruit, dense black cherry, and notes of brown spice (cocoa, nutmeg), dark chocolate, and hints of sandalwood. Perfect balance, great concentration and length, with fine, ripe tannins.
PAIRING	Pairs well with a grilled steak, roasted pork loin, veal, medium-strong cheeses, and most cream sauces.
