The standout in 2017 is the 2017 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Reine Jeanne, which is 85% Grenache and the rest Syrah and Mourvèdre that's still aging in foudres. It has a darker slant in its black and blue fruits, peppery herbs, and sappy garrigue, with terrific purity, concentration, focus, and length on the palate. I love its purity of fruit, and it's going to benefit from short-term cellaring.
