



CHÂTEAU PUECH-HAUT ARGALI ROSÉ 2019

Nestled on the shores of the Mediterranean and the foothills of the Cevennes region of southern France, Chateau Puech-Haut's vineyards span 625 acres in Côteaux du Languedoc AOC, including 230 acres in Saint Drézéry and 55 acres in Pic Saint Loup.

This rosé is a lovely pale color with a complex and flattering citrus nose. It offers aromas of red fruits such as raspberry and cherry with hints of citrus and peach blossom. The palate is fresh, round and balanced with mineral notes and a tangy finish on red berries.

Enjoy now with grilled chicken, a mushroom quiche or a flavorful summer salad like strawberry and spinach.
