VARIETIES

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc 16% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot

2018 VINTAGE

A mild growing season that led to overall high quality and quantity. Harvest took place October 17-25.

VINEYARD

Sustainably farmed, volcanic hillside vineyard located on the slope of Atlas Peak, overlooking Napa Valley. The select vine blocks produce smaller clusters and grape that naturally provide ample intensity of color, tannins, and texture.
