LIVELY WINES OF A DESERT OASIS

In the local native language, Amalaya means “hope for a miracle,” an expression that captivated Donald Hess and inspired his first project in Argentina. **That miracle was the discovery of water in the extreme high desert landscape of Argentina**, which allowed for careful cultivation of vines on soil never sown before, not even by the Incas.

The iconic Argentine varieties that blend into the wines of Amalaya are grown in Cafayate, the heart of the Calchaquí Valleys in northwestern Argentina. This wine region holds the distinction of comprising **some of the highest-altitude vineyards in the world, sitting at elevation ranging from 1,700 up to 3,300 meters (5,570 to 10,825 feet).**

The dry climate, significant daily temperature swings, and rocky, sandy soil together produce wines of unique style. **With their intense fruity expression, crisp acidity, and freshness, their vibrancy echoes the splashes of color among the sandstone formations of the area, enlivening every occasion.**

THE MAGIC OF FOUR ALTITUDES

Founded in 1831, Bodega Colomé is the oldest continuously working winery in Argentina. Likely established by the Spanish Governor of Salta, it received the first pre-phyloxera French Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon vines brought by the governor's daughter in 1854, some of which still contribute their fruit to Colomé wines. For Donald and Ursula Hess, who acquired the property in 2001, the winery became the fulfillment of a dream and a great adventure.

In a magical corner of the Calchaquí Valleys in Salta, they found a place where the extreme climate and many years of experience made it possible for **Bodega Colomé to create the world's most recognized high-altitude wines**, a mission that the next generation now continues. Grapes for the Colomé wines are grown in four vineyards at four different altitudes ranging from 1,750 to 3,111 meters (5,740 to 10,200 feet) above sea level - incredible heights within one of the world's very highest wine growing regions.

At these altitudes, dramatic daily temperature swings cause grapes to develop a concentrated, natural acidity, and the fierce sun exposure encourages thicker, darker grape skins. These factors produce aromatic wines of intense color and flavors that also exhibit a natural freshness.

The extreme microclimate here requires expertise and patience. Along with altitude, time is the other critical ingredient in the making of Colomé wines. **The team takes its time caring for the four vineyards with organic and biodynamic practices, giving the fruit time to ripen and mature in its natural environment**, and supporting the mystic energy that combines in the wines to reflect Salta's splendor.

TOURNON

FROM AN INTUITION TO LOVE AT FIRST SIGHT

Australia, the Earth's oldest continent in the world had always intrigued Michel Chapoutier. The diversity of ancient soils and terroirs in a region south of the equator, almost a world away from France inspired a vision: to grow Rhone Valley grapes in Australia. This vision was the beginning of a long journey of discovery and appreciation for the land.

In 1997 Michel realized this vision, with the creation of **Domaine Tournon**. Located in Victoria, on the south-eastern side of the continent, the region is recognized for its diversity of soils and microclimates. Within Victoria, two unique subzones (GI) Heathcote and Pyrenees were identified. Here, Michel and his team planted non-grafted vines from 19th century clonal selections, imported from Europe before the advent of phylloxera. These vineyards were then and continue to be farmed organically.

For Tournon, establishing a vineyard in a new land, while exciting, also provided many unique challenges. Kangaroos, often in groups of 200 roamed through the vineyards. Cockatoos, enticed by and eating all the red grapes. Moreover, strict water management, and the ever-present threat of fires proved daunting. Ultimately, humility, respect, and a deep desire to learn enabled Tournon to overcome these challenges and succeed.

For almost 30 years, Domaine Tournon, inspired by Michel's intuition and pioneering spirit, has garnered a reputation for producing a range of wines that truly reflect the special terroir of Victoria.

With an unwavering focus on Austria's signature grape, the estate produces an elegant and captivating style designed for international appeal and versatile food pairing. The wines are defined by brisk acidity, vibrant minerality, concentrated fruit, subtle spice and a voluptuous texture—an expression of Grüner Veltliner that is both authentic and cosmopolitan. Grapes are estate-grown in the Kamptal and carefully sourced from trusted growers in the Kamptal and neighboring Kremstal regions of Lower Austria, where Grüner Veltliner achieves optimal ripeness while retaining its hallmark freshness and vivacity.

Entirely devoted to Grüner Veltliner, **LAURENZ V.** produces a range of distinct proprietary styles, from light, crisp and fruit-driven to bold, complex and long-lasting—each created to elevate the table and enhance any occasion in good company. The portfolio includes three signature expressions: **SINGING Grüner Veltliner**, a lively and harmonious introduction to the house style, brimming with fresh fruit, mouthwatering spice and a hint of white pepper; **FRIENDLY Grüner Veltliner**, the classic Langenlois appellation wine, offering a soft yet vibrant palate supported by fine acidity, making it exceptionally food-friendly; and **CHARMING Grüner Veltliner**, the proprietary reserve, an assemblage of select single-vineyard sites in the Kamptal, matured on its lees for a minimum of 12 months to achieve depth, texture and remarkable elegance. Owned and managed by Dieter Hubler and the Schweiger family, LAURENZ V. is driven by the mission to establish Grüner Veltliner among the world's finest premium white wines.

LEGEND OF A MAN, LEGEND OF A WINE



In 1851, young Charles Heidsieck founded his own Champagne house in Reims. He understood that the United States was an important emerging market, so he traversed America repeatedly north to south promoting his new brand. The stylish entrepreneur became known lovingly as “Champagne Charlie.”

Charles Heidsieck Champagne is distinguished by the high proportion of reserve wines in the **Brut Réserve**. 40% of the blend is comprised of reserve wines averaging 10 years old, giving the wine uncommon depth and complexity. In addition to the non-vintage Brut Réserve and Rosé Réserve, the winery produces a Vintage Brut, Vintage Rosé, a Blanc de Blancs, and the prestige cuvée Blanc des Millénaires.

Only 60 crus from Champagne are allowed in the blend to create Charles Heidsieck Champagnes, but the three stylistic pillars that give the Brut Réserve its distinct character are Grand Cru Chardonnay from Oger in the Côte des Blancs, Grand Cru Pinot Noir from Ambonnay in the Montagne de Reims, and the distinct Pinot Meunier from Verneuil in the Vallée de Marne.

PIONEERS AMONG PIONEERS: DRIVEN BY LOVE FOR THE VINE

Only a few artisan winemakers existed in the Luberon in 1981, when Jean-Louis Descours, fell in love with this privileged land. It was then that the Descours found both a place of retreat and the Provençal art of living rooted in the terroir. **The presence of a few vines scattered among olive trees, cades and yews, drunk with the golden cymbals of the cicadas, called for a grand design: to make a very great red wine.**

Two Descours generations, first built a cellar with the help of Jean-Jacques Coll, a classic craftsman and talented oenologist with strong winegrowing convictions. They expanded the plantings until they doubled the existing vineyards of syrah and grenache joined with Rhône whites. **Surrounded by Luberon National Park, Château La Verrerie holds at its core unity of place with organic farming at the forefront of the wines they produce.** Since 2017, Valentine Tardieu-Vitali has brought a vision of producing red and white wines that are the most accurate representation of the terroir.

Their unwavering commitment to excellence and early adoption of organic principles in every aspect of vineyard management sets them apart as pioneers among pioneers. In an era where craftsmanship and authenticity are increasingly sought after, Château La Verrerie brings forth unique, artisanal wines that champions the Provençal life.

WINES THAT REFLECT THEIR REGION AND ORIGIN

The name Chapoutier occupies a storied place in the history of the Rhône Valley, beginning 1808, when the family first settled in the Rhône Valley. Throughout the 19th century and well into the next, M. CHAPOUTIER and its eponymous winery grew steadily, producing wine from esteemed vineyard sites such as Hermitage, Côte-Rôtie and Châteauneuf-du-Pape. However, 1990 was a watershed moment for the winery, with the arrival of Michel Chapoutier. Under his leadership, the maverick winemaker established bold initiatives. For example, the introduction of Single Vineyard Selection that express the unique terroir of a site, or wine labels embossed in braille for the visually impaired. In each instance, Michel's decisions were, and continue to be, driven by a deep respect for the soil, climate, and his fellow human beings.

Michel Chapoutier believes that only healthy vines growing within a balanced ecosystem can make great wine. Since 1990, The Maison M. CHAPOUTIER have pursued an unwavering commitment to practicing biodynamic viticulture. All chemical pesticides and herbicides are prohibited. Vineyards are nourished with organic matter, thereby preserving, and promoting the good bacteria inherent in healthy soils. Additionally, all vineyard decisions such as when to prune or harvest are informed by the cycles of the earth, sun, and moon.

A profound respect for nature and its rhythms inspires him to continually learn, improve and imagine new possibilities. This philosophy and practice have been validated time and time again, as M. CHAPOUTIER is the most awarded winery in the world, with more 100-point scores from Robert Parker and more 90+ ratings than any other winemaker.

Mathilde Chapoutier Selection inspires wine lovers to celebrate Discovery, Simplicity and Conviviality. **Leveraging her Rhône Valley heritage and winemaking know how, Mathilde explored numerous wine regions throughout France and around the world, to create a selection of her favorite wines to share with friends.** The compass symbolizes Mathilde's journey beyond the Rhône Valley, and her discovery of these terroirs.

In her quest to create a classically styled and vibrant Rosé, Mathilde identified the wine region of Provence in the south of France as an ideal terroir. Located east of Aix-en-Provence, at the foot of the Sainte-Victoire and Aurélien mountains, the vineyards here exhibit a wide array of exposures and soil-types that help to create complex wines. Crafting the best Rosé requires great care and timeliness. To this end, and to ensure maximum freshness and vibrancy, harvesting is carried out at night and quickly brought into the cellar, where grapes undergo a cool vinification in stainless steel tanks. The resulting wines are both delicious examples of Rosé.

The Côtes de Provence Orsuro is crisp and chock full of bright citrus and berry fruits, perfect for picnics, poolside sipping or simply enjoying with family and friends. The Côtes de Provence Saint-Victoire Aurisso exhibits a touch more amplitude and depth, making it a fantastic choice for bistro-style dining or Mediterranean inspired fare!

When Henri-Guillaume Piper joined the House in 1815 alongside Christian Heidsieck, the trio expanded its reputation far beyond the borders of France.

Today, Piper-Heidsieck brings together Champagne lovers in more than 80 countries and remains the Most Awarded Champagne House of the Century*, recognized worldwide for its uncompromising commitment to quality. Guided by its founder’s philosophy to “seriously create,” the House approaches Champagne-making with precision in every detail and mastery built over time, crafting wines that combine technical excellence with expressive character. For Piper-Heidsieck, product excellence is only the beginning; every bottle is designed to move, inspire and entertain. Blending sophistication with audacity, the House transforms every occasion into a vibrant expression of celebration.

Since 2018, Piper-Heidsieck has been guided by one of Champagne’s youngest chief winemakers, Émilien Boutillat, entrusted with preserving the House’s distinctive philosophy while leading it toward a bold and sustainable future.

Deeply committed to protecting the terroir of Champagne, Piper-Heidsieck has held dual VDC and HVE** certifications since 2015. The House became the first B Corp Certified Champagne House in 2022, joined the IWCA*** that same year, and renewed its B Corp certification in 2025. Working alongside partner growers across 319 crus in the Montagne de Reims, Vallée de la Marne, Côte des Blancs and Côte des Bar, the House advances environmentally responsible practices that promote biodiversity, reduce chemical inputs and support thoughtful resource management.

Today, one bottle of Piper-Heidsieck is popped somewhere in the world every six seconds—an enduring testament to a House that has been seriously creating wines that smile for more than 240 years.

The House only produces this iconic champagne in the most exceptional of vintages with distinctive character and unparalleled longevity. Each Rare Millésime is born from a struggle with nature, for instance Rare Millésime 1976 was created after an exceptional drought and Rare Millésime 1985 was created following a terrible black frost. Defying the usual approach to terroir selection, blending and storage, Régis selects the vineyards according to their expression rather than their rank in the scale of Premier and Grand Crus. He prefers the Pinot Noir grapes from Verzy or Aÿ for their sheer intensity and powerful silky texture and he selects Chardonnay grapes from the Montagne de Reims, a region famous for Pinot Noir. He thinks outside the box and uses an unconventional blending approach to create an emblematic silky texture, endless freshness and precise minerality.

One of the top five prestige cuvées of the world, Rare Champagne is internationally renowned for its distinguished style, its unique blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, for its signature exotic notes, and for its infinite freshness and purity. Rare Champagne has been crafted by unique expertise, a sophisticated vision and by the most demanding of standards making it the true exception from the region.

ONE HOUSE, ONE PHILOSOPHY

Founded in 1928 by Henri Claudius Trénel, Maison Trénel is one of the most ancient and well-known houses of the Beaujolais and the Mâcon wine regions of France. For nearly a century, the house has had the great fortune of working with vineyards superbly situated and judiciously farmed. These vines consistently yield very high-quality fruit. For example, some of the vines for Trénel's Beaujolais-Villages are upwards of 60 years of age.

Maison Trénel is guided by the principles of authenticity of fruit, and authenticity of terroir. The house has always strived to produce wines & fruit liqueurs that exemplify the purest expression of their origins. This sentiment is born from a love of the land, as well as a deep respect and continued practice of Burgundian traditions. It also informs the house's work ethic, written in Latin and evidenced on Maison Trénel's emblem: Bene Facit Id Quod Bene Amat, or "...we can only succeed at that which we know well, and love."

In 2015 Maison Trénel was bought by M. CHAPOUTIER to renew focus on highlighting the differences between vineyard sites and terroirs. As such, the wines from Maison Trénel continue to reach even greater heights.

In 1982, Giacosa began to acquire prime parcels in Serralunga d'Alba, La Morra and Barbaresco to produce wines that are rightly regarded as the finest expressions of Nebbiolo.

His legacy rests with daughter Bruna, who continues to uphold her father's winemaking philosophy to respect traditional techniques while using the best of modern technology. The goal is for each distinguished site to produce articulate, unique wines.

Donnafugata was established in Sicily by a family that has been able to innovate the style and perception of Sicilian wine throughout the world.

Giacomo Rallo, the fourth generation of a family with over 170 years of experience in quality wine, founded Donnafugata in 1983 together with his wife Gabriella. Today, their children José and Antonio lead the company and a team of people focused on excellence.

Donnafugata represents the artisan and creative excellence of Made in Italy. It is a winery in perpetual motion towards innovation and focused on small valuable productions from unique territories and vineyards.

Sicily is a wine-growing continent and Donnafugata embodies this diversity cultivating its vineyards in very different contexts.

The winery can count on a historic family cellar in Marsala and four estates with vineyards and vinification cellars: in western Sicily, in Contessa Entellina, where Donnafugata has 848 acres of vineyards with 19 different grape varieties; in the volcanic island of Pantelleria, Donnafugata has 168 acres of Zibibbo cultivated with low bush vines called “alberello pantesco” (Unesco Intangible Cultural Heritage).

In eastern Sicily, on the northern slope of Mount Etna, Donnafugata has 86 acres of vineyards with native grapes such as Carricante and Nerello Mascalese; in the territory of Vittoria DOC, the latest generation winery is surrounded by 103 acres of Nero d'Avola and Frappato.

Sustainability is part of Donnafugata's DNA: from good practices in the field to biodiversity, from energy saving to the production of clean energy and landscape protection. In 2021 Donnafugata joined SOSTain, the sustainability program for Sicilian viticulture, according to the goals of the UN 2030 Agenda.

The dialogue with art makes Donnafugata special: its artistic labels are inspired by Gabriella and created by Stefano Vitale; they are unique and perfectly tell the world and colors of Donnafugata.

Founded in 1956 by Francesco De Marchi, Isole e Olena is a historic Chianti Classico estate located near Castellina in Chianti, Barberina Val d'Elsa. Spanning 56 hectares (138 acres) at 350-450 meters (1,148 – 1,476 feet) above sea level, its vineyards thrive on galestro and marly schist soils.

In 1975, Paolo De Marchi took over, initiating a new era marked by vineyard innovations aimed at elevating local grape varieties, particularly Sangiovese, through meticulous massal selection and soil mapping. This visionary approach established Isole e Olena as a pioneer in the quality resurgence of Chianti Classico from the 1970s onwards.

A milestone came in 1980 with the debut of Cepparello, a Sangiovese aged in barrique initially classified as “vino da tavola” but later recognized as one of the first Supertuscans, showcasing Sangiovese’s character and longevity from this high-altitude terroir.

In 2023, Emanuele Reolon joined as the new Estate Director after a year working closely with Paolo De Marchi. With a commitment to continuing the winery’s legacy of crafting wines with distinct personalities, Emanuele brings his experience to further unlock the estate’s potential. His leadership aims to preserve and enhance the fine quality and complexity of Isole e Olena’s wines, ensuring they continue to stand at the forefront of Chianti Classico production.

Today, Isole e Olena remains a beacon of Chianti Classico, renowned for its authentic style – fragrant, balanced, and fruit-forward – reflecting its unique altitude. Alongside Chianti Classico and Cepparello, the estate produces exceptional single varietals like Chardonnay, Syrah, and Cabernet Sauvignon, as well as an acclaimed Vin Santo.

Tiraki's story began on Longfield Farm, purchased by the Hammond family in 1870, where six generations have worked the land. What started as a traditional farming property evolved into a vineyard in 1999, cultivating some of Marlborough's most celebrated varieties—Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir.

Founded in 2020, Tiraki—meaning “clearing of the sky” in Māori—honors both the distinctive Marlborough climate and the Hammond family's Ngāi Tahu Māori heritage, which has been deeply intertwined with the land for over 150 years. Rooted in the rolling landscapes of the Southern Valleys, Longfield Farm has transformed from a multi-generational farming operation into a premier single-vineyard winery.

Led by winemaker Josh Hammond, alongside his siblings Tyler and EllaRose and their parents Lynne and Rob, Tiraki is dedicated to crafting elegant, expressive wines that showcase the purity, vibrancy, and depth of Marlborough's terroir. Every bottle reflects the family's meticulous care—blending traditional wisdom with modern innovation to create wines of exceptional quality.

As New Zealand's first B Corp-certified wine brand, with a score of 102.5, Tiraki is committed to sustainability, ethical business practices, and giving back. Their vineyards are undergoing organic conversion, they use eco-friendly packaging, and they donate 2% of their revenue annually to biodiversity initiatives that protect native ecosystems.

Tiraki is more than a winery—it's a reflection of family, heritage, and a deep respect for the land.

PORTUGAL. THE DOURO. A LEGENDARY VALLEY.

The inception for Dos Lusiadas began in 2009, when Michel Chapoutier and local growers decided to cultivate Touriga Nacional, Portugal’s most admired indigenous variety. This collaboration resulted in the creation of Eleivera and Pinteivera, two classically styled wines made from Touriga Nacional.

This low-yielding vine produces small, thick-skinned berries with high fruit concentration. Touriga Nacional wines are often deeply colored, formidably structured, and exhibit a distinctive floral character on the nose. When expertly vinified, the wines can be cellared for medium to long-term ageing.

In 2001, the Douro Valley was awarded status as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This notable accolade recognizes the long tradition of culture and winemaking that the region has preserved over the centuries and shared with the world.

IN THE HEART OF DOURO VALLEY, A PRECIOUS TERROIR ORGANICALLY FARMED

Dominio del Soto is located Sotillo de la Ribera, at the center of the Ribera del Duero in northwestern Spain. This artisanal winery was established in 2005, and presently farms 16 hectares of organically grown vines. The vineyards here are predominantly comprised of Tempranillo, known locally as Tinto Fino or Tinta del País. It is from these vines that Dominio del Soto creates its unique and energetic renditions of Roble and Crianza wines.

Complex and rugged are two characteristics that aptly describe the Ribera del Duero. Although the vineyards extend over 70 miles along both sides of the Duero River, the region often experiences cold, harsh winters, followed by hot, dry summers. **Extreme temperature changes, or diurnal shifts as great as 50 degrees encourage ideal ripening conditions for the early-ripening Tempranillo grape variety.**

The vineyards at Dominio del Soto are planted on high-terraced vineyard sites at an average altitude of 850-900m above sea level. The soils of the wine region, a combination of deep clay-limestone, marly-limestone interspersed with pockets of sand are predominantly sedimentary in nature. **The region's unique soils and harsh climate enable Tempranillo to yield characterful and intense wines that still display freshness and balance.**

Dutton-Goldfield’s mission is to **craft world-class wines that express the personalities of their cool-climate home, through a brightness of fruit, complexity, structure and balance.** The winery was born of a handshake in a vineyard in 1998, when longtime colleagues and friends Steve Dutton and Dan Goldfield recognized this shared vision.

Warren Dutton, Steve’s father, began growing grapes in the western reaches of Russian River Valley, and was the first to plant chardonnay in its coldest corners, in the mid-1960s, at a time when most people thought the area was too cool to grow fruit for quality still wine. Dutton Ranch enjoys this legacy with a choice collection of 80 vineyards today, from which Dutton-Goldfield receives the best possible quality of grapes each harvest.

From their favorite Dutton Ranch parcels, Steve and Dan select the vineyards that will blend together to become quintessential Russian River expressions. They then choose a few special sites that epitomize their terroir to bottle in limited-production single-vineyard wines. Dutton-Goldfield’s pinots have balance and individuality, and elicit the flavors of the piece of earth from which they come. The chardonnays are from the old, cold, dry-farmed vineyards of Green Valley that provide a vibrant citrus core, focused fruit, great richness and solid acidity, even after full barrel and malolactic fermentation.

COMPOSING A NEW CHAPTER IN THE MONDAVI FAMILY WINEMAKING STORY

For four generations, the Mondavi family has crafted world-class wines in the Napa Valley. In 1999, Michael Mondavi, together with wife Isabel, son Rob Jr., and daughter Dina, purchased the land to plant the Animo vineyard in Atlas Peak, establishing the Michael Mondavi Family Estate. Today, the estate is comprised of Animo and Oso Vineyards, two distinct sites with unique growing conditions and terroirs, and the family makes wines under the Animo, Emblem, and M by Michael Mondavi names.

The Animo Vineyard is situated in the Foss Valley subzone in the southeastern quadrant of Napa Valley. The 15-acre parcel is planted nearly entirely to Cabernet Sauvignon and is comprised of a relatively uniform rocky, volcanic soil infused with streaks of iron. The vine rows climb Atlas Peak from an elevation of 1,200 to 1,350 feet overlooking the southern end of Napa Valley.

The second property of the Michael Mondavi Family Estate is the Oso Vineyard. This 95-acre, thirty-year-old vineyard is nestled between Ink Grade and Howell Mountain in northeastern Napa Valley, with stone-lined terraces sloping at an elevation of over 1,200 feet. Purchased by the Michael Mondavi family in 2006, the Oso Vineyard draws its name from the Spanish word for bear, a reference to those that frequent the vineyard to feast on ripe grapes in the fall.

Tony's life-long relationships with grape growers throughout the Napa Valley are the key to Oberon's quality. He is able to draw on those friendships to reliably obtain top quality fruit at a fair price year after year. For Oberon, Tony selects Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay grapes throughout Napa's finest winegrowing regions, including Oakville, Oak Knoll, Yountville, Chiles Valley and Capell Valley.

By layering together structured hillside fruit, plush fruit from the alluvial valley floor and fruit sourced from diverse soils within the valley, Tony crafts quintessential Napa Valley wines: complex, flavorful wines with ample natural acidity. Oberon Cabernet Sauvignon is a classic Napa Cabernet with deep, rich color and concentrated blackberry and cassis flavors. The Merlot shows textbook plum and black currant flavors and silky texture. The Sauvignon Blanc is partially fermented in barrel, adding body and texture to the vibrant green apple, kiwi, pear and melon fruit flavors. The Carneros Chardonnay is an expressive, approachable, fruit-forward wine with notes of caramelized white pear, fresh Fuji and Golden Delicious apple, and torched crème brûlée.

WORLD-CLASS SPARKLING WINES FROM THE HEART OF SONOMA COUNTY

Piper Sonoma was founded in 1980 by the Marquis d'Aulan family, direct descendants of the Piper family. Recognizing Sonoma as a great growing region for Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, and believing in its terroir, the family's vision was to produce world-class sparkling wines in the New World, using old-world winemaking techniques. Over 40 years later, the Piper Sonoma winemaking team continues to realize that vision and produces premium sparkling wines under the guidance of long-time winemaker Peter Krauter.

With over 40 years of experience in Sonoma County, the winemaking team sources from more than 20 growers, some of whom, like the Green, Young and Ledbetter families, have been supplying grapes for more than three decades. Many growers have adopted voluntary no-till farming practices, with a strict adherence to hillside ordinances. Sustainable agriculture and integrated pest management techniques have been implemented and organic or naturally derived fertilizers are utilized, while composted grape material is used as fertilizer to increase water efficiency and help build soil structure.

Piper Sonoma handcrafts their sparkling wines from the classic varietals: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Blanc, by *méthode traditionnelle*, the same technique used to craft the best champagnes. Each parcel is pressed and fermented separately, creating an extensive selection of base wines to choose from. Winemaker Keith Hock then tastes each component and selects those base wines that show potential to produce exceptional wine. The cuvée is placed *en tirage* for secondary fermentation in the bottle prior to disgorgement. Finally, a small percentage of older reserve wine is included in the *liqueur d'expedition* adding further complexity and texture.
